


<u>FITTING INSTRUCTIONS FOR BG0002</u> <u>BELT GUARD (LOWER) FOR HARLEY DAVIDSON STREET 500 '14- & STREET 750</u> '15-



THIS KIT CONTAINS THE ITEMS PICTURED AND LABELLED BELOW.
DO NOT PROCEED UNTIL YOU ARE SURE ALL PARTS ARE PRESENT.

Please note that the way the kit is packed does not necessarily represent the way of mounting to the bike.

LEGEND

 $\overline{\text{ITEM 1}} = M6 \text{ x 25mm LONG BUTTON HEAD BOLT}$ (x1).

ITEM $2 = M6 \times 30 \text{mm}$ LONG BUTTON HEAD BOLT (x1).

ITEM 3 = ALUMINIUM LOWER BELT GUARD OUTER (SMW0056) (x1).

ITEM 4 = BRUSHED PLATE (PLATE 0174) (x1).

ITEM 5 = ALUMINIUM LOWER BELT GUARD INNER (SMW0055) (x1).

ITEM 6 = SPACER (S0104 - 12mm LONG) (x1).

ITEM 7 = SPACER (S0230 - 6mm LONG) (x1).

Please note that in cases where kits are packed with rubber washers holding the components onto the bolt – *the rubber washers should be thrown away!*

TOOLS REQUIRED

- 4mm Allen key.
- 10mm socket & wrench.

FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

- Remove the two bolts that secure the OEM lower belt guard in place, as arrowed in picture 1 and remove the guard from the bike, as shown in picture 2.
- Take the R&G Belt Guard and assemble it as shown in the exploded diagram and picture 3, with the longer bolt and longer spacer aligned with the front hole.
- Offer this assembly up to the bike and feed the back plate over the top of the belt and rotate downwards to locate in the correct position, as shown in picture 4.
- Fit the two bolts loosely into the J-clips on the swingarm mounting tabs, as shown in pictures 5 & 6.
- With both bolts located, ensure the belt guard is mounted correctly before tightening all bolts evenly.

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

ARTICLE 3 = PROTECTION INFERIEURE EN ALUMINIUM EXTERIEURE (SMW0056) (x1).

ARTICLE 4 = PLAQUE BROSSEE (PLAQUE 0174) (x1).

ARTICLE 5 = PROTECTION INFERIEURE EN ALUMINIUM (SMW0055) (x1).

ARTICLE 6 = ENTRETOISE (S0104 - 12mm DE LONG) (x1).

ARTICLE 7 = ENTRETOISE (S0230 - 6mm DE LONG) (x1).

Notez que si les kits sont emballés avec des rondelles en caoutchouc servant à tenir les composants, ces rondelles doivent être jetées.

OUTILS REQUIS

- Clé Allen 4mm.
- Clé et douille de 10mm.



FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

- Enlever les 2 boulons qui fixent la protection inférieure d'origine en place, voir photo 1 puis enlever la protection de la moto, voir photo 2.
- Prendre la protection R&G et l'assembler comme sur le schéma ci-dessus et la photo 3, avec le boulon le plus long et l'entretoise alignés avec le trou à l'avant.
- Monter cet ensemble sur la moto et passer la plaque arrière sur le haut de la protection puis tournez la vers le bas pour la placer en bonne position, voir photo 4.
- Placer les 2 boulons dans les J-clips sur les onglets de fixation du bras oscillant, voir photos 5 & 6.
- Une fois ces 2 boulons placés, veiller à ce que la protection soit fixée correctement avant de serrer tous les boulons de façon identique.
